- To send naked photos or videos of yourself.

- Threaten to show your photos and videos to other people unless you send more.



 You might not like the sexual things they ask you to do but feel you have no choice.



You <u>always</u> have the right to say NO.

- It is a crime to share your images or video without your permission.
- If you feel unsafe at home, it is OK to leave.
