Commercial Sexual Exploitation can include:

- prostitution
- lap dancing
- stripping
- pornography
- human trafficking
- someone pressuring you to have sex or do sexual things for money, rent or food.

No one should ever be forced into sexual activity without consent.

You always have the right to say **NO**.

It is a crime for intimate images to be shared without your permission.

How to get help:

For non-emergency police help call **101**.

For urgent medical assistance call **999** in an emergency.
For non-emergency dial NHS 24 on **111**.
